



Drawing & painting at St Anne's

Teaching will be appropriate for beginners and people with experience.

'Life drawing' Tuesdays, 10am-12.15

Combine guidance to "do your own thing" with optional course projects to explore approaches to drawing and art materials. The main emphasis is on how to draw what you see. The tutor provides easels, drawing boards and models. Students are asked to please provide their own art materials. There is sometimes a double model pose.

'Art for All' Wednesdays, 10am-12noon

A general art workshop including the tutor continuing his own work. Returners are assisted to develop their chosen themes while beginners may follow the tutor's projects to learn about use of art materials and exploration of topics.

'Portraiture' Thursdays, 10.15-12.15

Capture the likeness and character of the human face in a portrait drawing and painting class. You will have a variety of models to work from. Teaching will be appropriate for beginners and people with experience.
